Foundations of Leadership

Grades 8 & 9

Foundations offers a strong base of theoretical and practical leadership skills. Youth spend time making connections and learning about our community while also doing volunteer work that supports Neighbourhood House programs and volunteering at other events around town. Youth are encouraged to come and check out a session anytime!

Grades 10 & 11

Youth are trained and then volunteer in our licensed School Aged Child Care facilities. This program is also a way for youth to complete the required 'Career Prep' hours for High School graduation.

Leadership 2

Grades 11 & 12

Leadership 2 emphasizes leadership through one of three streams: fundraising, mentorship (of Grade 7's) or event planning/facilitation. Although the three paths are mostly self-directed, the Staff are there to guide youth through the planning process.

Youth will gain leadership and employment readiness skills which will be beneficial to many areas of their futures such as post-secondary/scholarship applications and job placement.
