Program Highlights

Phase 1: Paid training (4 weeks/20 hours per week of online training)

- Earn minimum wage while you learn
- Four weeks of training covering topics such as resume & cover letter preparation, interviewing skills, job search skills, networking skills, worker safety and worker rights awareness and more
- Life skills workshops which include: financial literacy, communications, working with others, critical thinking skills and computer skills.
- Classes take place online. Study at your own pace from the safety and comfort of your home.

Phase 2: Work Experience with an Employer (8 weeks/ 35 hours per week)

- Connecting with and referrals to employers
- Eight weeks of paid work placement
- One-to-one coaching to help you find a good job

Program Eligibility

- 15-30 years of age
- Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or a Refugee Status (with Permanent Residency and Permanent SIN) legally entitled to work in Canada
- Not a full-time student
- Not actively participating in another government funded training program
- Unemployed or precariously employed
- A resident of Metro Vancouver Area
