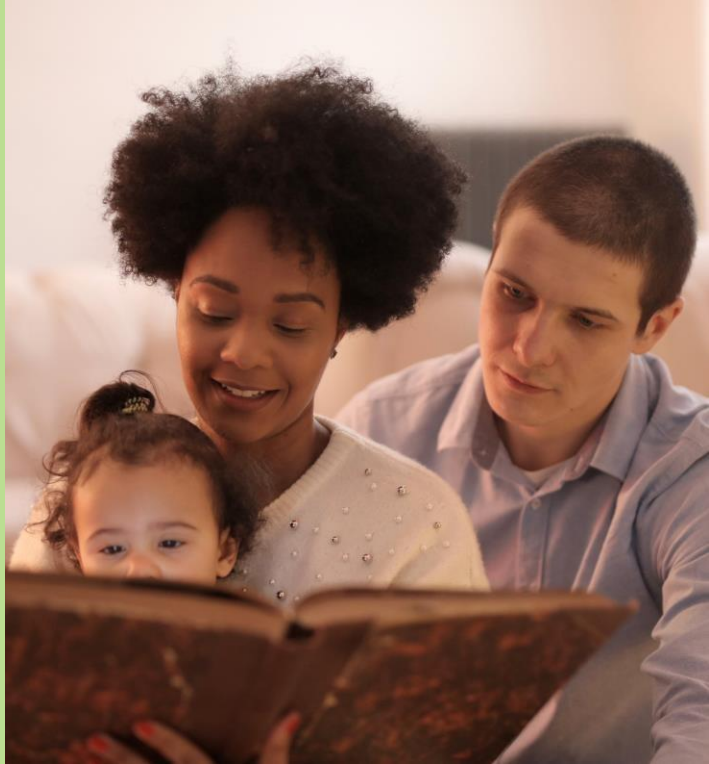
About BNH
